REGULAR MEETING OF THE WELLSBORO MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY December 20, 2022

The meeting of the Wellsboro Municipal Authority was called to order by Bob DeCamp on Tuesday, December 20, 2022 at 4:04 p.m. Meeting in the Council Room of the Borough Office at 14 Crafton Street were Bob DeCamp, Ed Owlett, Terry Bryant, Jim Bodine and Daren Getty, constituting a quorum. Secretary/Treasurer Amy Kane Perry, Borough Manager Louis Rachiele were also in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Public Comments on Agenda Items-none

Jim Bodine made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 15, 2022 Wellsboro Municipal Meeting. The motion was seconded by Daren Getty and carried.

Items:

<u>Diversified Oil & Gas Royalty</u> – We have not received a check from Diversified Oil & Gas this month.

<u>Water Sales</u> – Water sales totaled 2,633,862 gallons for the month of November. Revenue was \$18,437.00.

<u>Jet Vac Replacement</u> – The new Vactor Jet Vac from A&H Equipment is expected by June of 2023.

<u>Banik Well Conveyance Line</u> – Terry Bryant made a motion to move forward with design and bidding for the line connecting the Banik Well to Willis Run. The motion was seconded by Ed Owlett and carried.

<u>Water Tank Purchase</u> – The purchase is still under discussion. The solicitor has provided a list of concerns that need addressed. Discussions will continue with both the railroad and GROW.

<u>Keck Well Update</u> – In the meeting with Joe McNally it was confirmed that if we wish to draw water, we should look for another location that may not affect/draw down the protected wet lands.

Update From Larson Design - Shawn Downey sent a memo with the following updates:

- CSO still waiting for Martz to fine tune once a CSO event occurs.
- Application for the PA Small Water and Sewer Grant has been completed for the UV project. The application has been submitted.

Daren Getty made a motion to amend Wellsboro Municipal Authority Resolution No. 2022-02 authorizing the submission for a PA Small Water and Sewer Grant from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to include WMA Chair, Robert DeCamp as a designated signer. The motion was seconded by Jim Bodine and carried.

The System Hydraulic Characterization portion of the Long Term Control Plan has been submitted to DEP.

Pay Bills

Jim Bodine made a motion to ratify the payment of bills and pay bills in the amount of \$33,871.73. Ed Owlett seconded the motion and it carried.
