HAZARD TREE REMOVAL: Scott Nichols made a motion to submit a list of hazardous trees that need to come down to other tree removal personnel for prices. Bob McCarthy 2nd. Passed. The Commission will follow policy with the land owners as written.

TREE PLANTING: Peter Herres reported that there will be 15-17 trees planted at the Charleston Baseball fields. There will be three trees planted at Packer Park and the rest we be planted around town. The total amount 20-25 trees. A request that maples be planted at the ballfields was reported by the Borough Manager, Daniel K Strausser.

TREE VITALIZE: We will submit a grant for pruning in the next round of grants. Can be used for pruning or inventory with a 50/50 contribution.

PERMITS: None

TREE CITY USA: We were approved for Tree City USA. Confirmation came from Steve Hoover.

OTHER BUSINESS: Scott Nichols reported that there is a new bug called Oak Wilt that was found in the Canyon area. It is transmitted by beetles and can go from oak tree to oak tree through the root systems. The tree will bud and the leaves will turn green then fall off.
