Other Business-

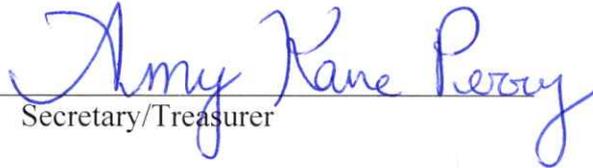
